## February 7. **DATUM FOUNDATION**

Since its inception in 2004, Datum has built nearly twenty schools, orphanages and clinics in Asia and Africa. Datum is dedicated to giving time, energy and resources to help poor vulnerable children of the world without discrimination of gender, race or religion.

- 14. **SEND A COW** is an international charity based in Bath, supporting the most marginalized in rural Zambia, Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Burundi and Uganda to become self-sustaining farmers and small business owners. Cows are now sourced locally. They enable families to work together to grow nutritious crops to feed themselves and their families and sell surplus crops at market to generate income to send their children to school.
- 21. **THE SUSSEX SNOWDROP TRUST** provides care at home for children with life threatening and terminal illnesses.
- 28. **CHRISTIAN ENGINEERS IN DEVELOPMENT** serves developing countries with technical skills.
- March 7. **MOSAIC MIDDLE EAST** (FRRME) have changed their name to Mosaic Middle East but their legal name remains the same. It has ambitious goals for 2024 to improve the lives of thousands of people in Iraq and Jordan.

  - 2. 4 new Olive Tree Centres. The first Olive Tree Centre in Jordan supports refugees with a range of educational, therapeutic and empowerment programmes. In partnership with local Jordanian churches, we will enable new Centres to greatly expand their impact.
  - 3. 2,000 beneficiaries of our NINEVEH SEED Development Programme partnering with Iraqi NGOs' have already provided 7 new businesses and job creation projects through sustainable development. We aim to set up a further 35-45 projects in the next 3 years.
  - 4. Advocacy support for 1,000 refugees and their families.
  - 20,000 patient treatment visits at St. George's Clinic, Baghdad each year.

Release puts out a magazine called Voice of Persecuted Christians with news, stories and prayer requests from persecuted Christians around the world.
- 18. **FRIENDS OF THE CHILDREN OF ROMANIA** provides a secure and happy home to children who have none, a home where each child can be loved and cared for as an individual, a home where each care for one another as in the families they don't possess. The first children who came out of the notorious orphanages of the Communist regime are now grown up and have left home. There are now a new generation of children in its care. Father Martin has supported them for twenty-seven years and is a Director and Trustee.
- 25. **BEATS** praise the Lord for recent answers to prayer for BEATS's projects in West Indonesia, especially in the success of online learning during Covid19 and providing the funding for teachers' salaries for the whole of 2020. They ask the Lord to continue helping the staff at YACAN (pronounced Yar-Chan) and YASAH Children's Homes to provide excellent care for the children and students, and like our our youngsters, help them to re-adjust post-pandemic, praying that Indonesia will soon recover from this virus.
