DECEMBER

- 5th. Sage House Dementia
SAGE HOUSE DEMENTIA SUPPORT is a young and exciting West Sussex charity based in Tangmere. It works with voluntary and charitable organisations, the NHS, West Sussex County Council and other statutory organisations to create a unique community hub for dementia to enhance well-being and quality of life for local people living with dementia, their families and carers.
- 12th. St. Wilfrid's Hospice
ST. WILFRID'S HOSPICE offers specialist care to patients at home, in hospital and in the Hospice. St. Wilfrid's new hospice for the 21st century has opened its doors here in Bosham.
- 19th. Voices of Exile – BVI
The Diocesan appeal through VIE Brighton to support refugees to Sussex for resettlement in the country.
- 24th. Chichester Association for Family Support
CHICHESTER DIOCESAN ASSOCIATION FOR FAMILY SUPPORT help families in Sussex to overcome their difficulties and prevent crisis. They support families struggling with issues such as poverty, ill health, learning difficulties, bereavement, family break-up and domestic abuse.
- 25th. Stonepillow
STONEPILLOW works with homeless and vulnerable people in the Chichester area towards inclusion and wellbeing. At the moment stocks of food are very low in Chichester. They are feeding 50 extra rough sleepers. Please see appeal on pew leaflet.
- 26th. The Children's Society
CHILDREN'S SOCIETY is a Church of England society raising funds and Awareness for children in poverty. They usually raise money with the Christingle Service but were unable to do so this year.
